# 2020 Supplementary Appropriation No.1

The following 2020 Supplementary Appropriation of \$750,000 is presented pursuant to the requirements of section 15 of the Public Finance Act.

#### Introduction

This first supplementary appropriation for 2020 was prepared to cater for unforeseen and urgent costs that emanated during the course of the current financial year, beyond the approved 2020 National Budget. These priority items were identified as emergency expenditures requiring urgent funding. Any additional charges on the consolidated fund above the approved estimates requires the approval of Parliament.

Therefore this supplementary appropriation consists of estimates of additional money being spent.

The allocation of \$300,000 will enable the Government to provide a donation to the Government of Australia to financially support victims of the bush fire and a top up \$46,000 will be used to cover expenses related to the Hon. Prime Minister's tour to outer islands.

A provision of \$200,000 is required for Government to implement protective measures to mitigate the risks of spreading the coronavirus. Thus this allocation is needed to meet related costs such as daily subsistence allowance for those who observe the quarantine period in Fiji and other related costs across all sectors.

The overhauling of the Talamona is one of the major activity the Fisheries Department planned to implement this year. Therefore, this allocation is a top up to meet all costs related to the maintenance of the Talamoana in Suva, Fiji.

Savings within the current 2020 fiscal year and drawdown from the Tuvalu Consolidate Investment Fund (CIF) will finance this first supplementary appropriation.
