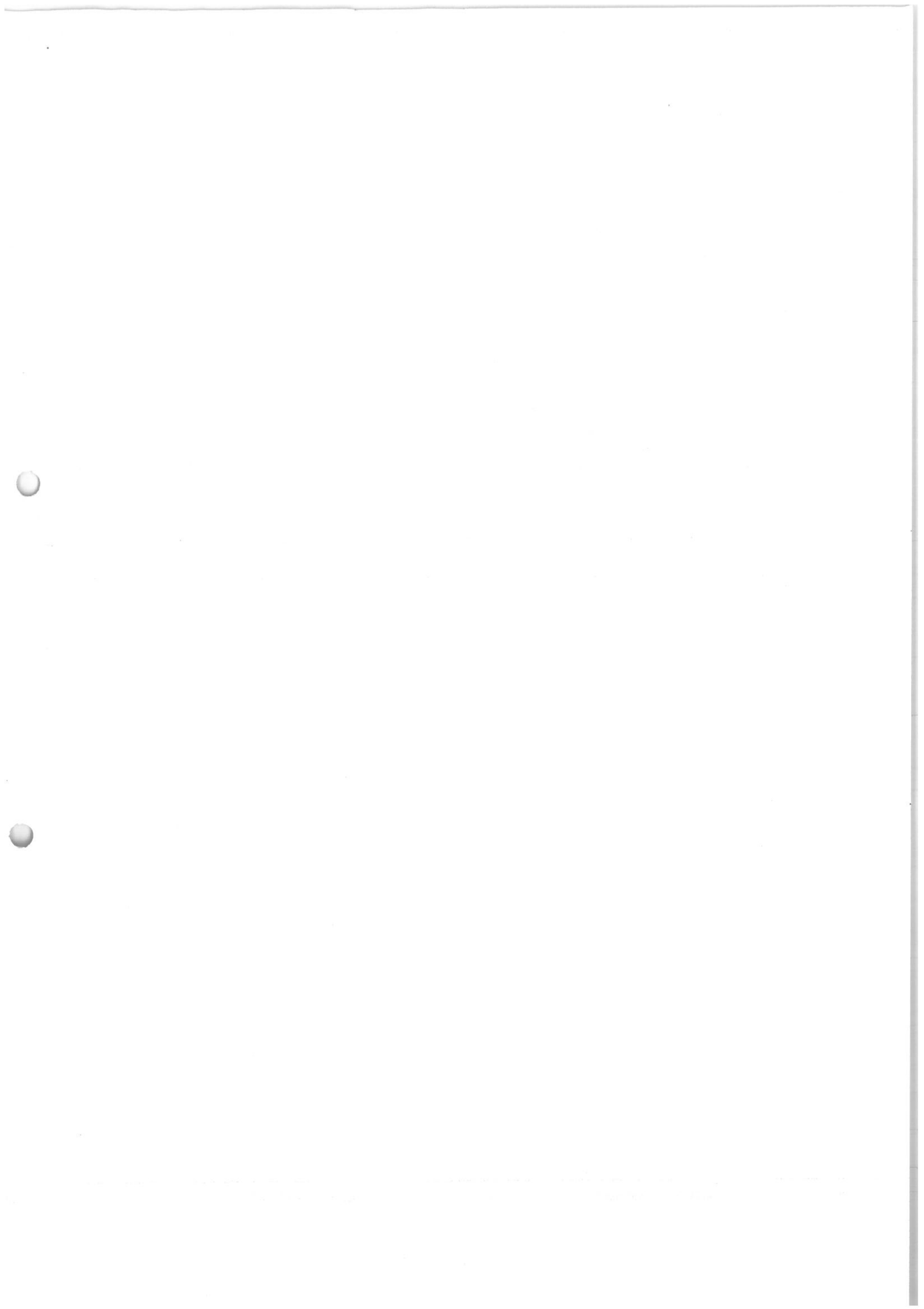

AN ACT TO AUTHORISE A SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION OF MONIES OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND FOR EXPENDITURES TO THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING 31 DECEMBER 2019

1 Short Title

This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act (No.1) 2019.

2 Authorisation of Expenditure

The Minister may by warrant under his hand, in addition to the sum already authorised for the service of Tuvalu for the financial year ending 31 December 2019, further authorise the issue from the Consolidated Fund for the service of the same financial year a sum not exceeding **seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars (AUD\$750,000.00)** and which sum be appropriated in accordance with the Schedule for the purposes specified.




