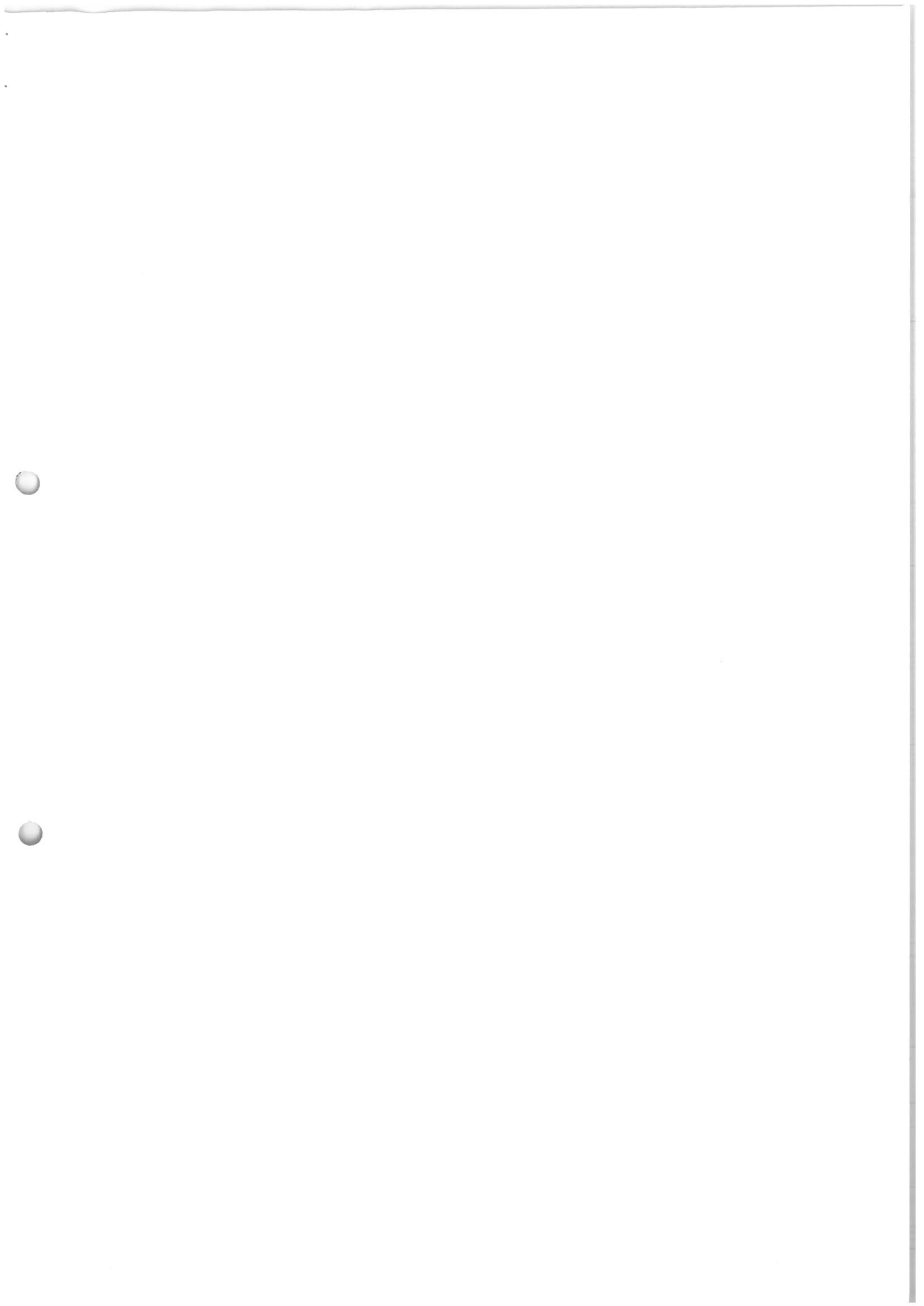

**AN ACT TO AUTHORISE SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET UNDER SECTION
165 (2)(B) FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF MONIES OUT OF THE
CONSOLIDATED FUND FOR EXPENDITURES TO THE SERVICE OF
THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING 31 DECEMBER 2018**

1 Short Title

This Act may be cited as the SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET Act 2018.

2 Purpose

The Supplementary Budget 2018 is presented in pursuant to the requirements under section 165 (2) (b) of the Constitution with payment to be effective before 31 December 2018.

3 Authorisation of expenditure

Additional funds in the sum not exceeding \$10,872,187 (*ten million, eight hundred and seventy two thousand, one hundred and eighty seven dollars*) are required for the service of the financial year, to be appropriated in accordance with the Schedule for the purpose specified.
